No this is not a new dance!

Those who attended the SQUARE training at CERT in May are particularly encouraged to attend.

**Everyone is welcome even if you didn't get to the first SQUARE training session it doesn't matter, if you're a little late still come along, we value everyone's input.**

This will be our Wrap up session on the SQUARE training with Marita. We will watch a DVD have some discussion and formulate our 'Pathway to Care Plan' for our community so it is really important we get lots of people there so the 'Plan' represents our community needs.

By the end of the session we plan to have put together a plan of action for people to refer to when they are faced with a crisis situation particularly in relation to people's mental wellbeing. **For example; who to contact if you are present when someone has a mental breakdown or is suicidal**, whether it be violent or passive, if there is a risk to other people present, or only the individual experiencing the breakdown. You may have been in this situation yourself and if you have, your contribution to this plan is vital (e.g. by telling us what you didn't know), because it is usually at this point **when we are desperate and scared that we ask ourselves the question; what do I do now? (and we do have a 'duty of care')**. The 'Pathway to Care Plan' is to help us answer this question.

The plan is for all households in our community to have a copy of this plan, as well it will go on our website at [www.nangiloc.vic.au](http://www.nangiloc.vic.au) and it will form part of our community's "Look out for your neighbours" program identified in the Nangiloc/Colignan & District Community Plan.
