NIT ALERT

ASBESTOS CLEANUP

As advertised earlier, the house that bent down (Rodney Donaldson) near the kinder over the holidays had an asbestos roof. The clean up of the site will be undertaken on Friday Feb 22nd starting at 7.30am. The Department of Education has been notified and they are requesting that school be conducted off site on this day, with the safety of students and staff their highest priority. The Department have also provided \$300 to cover all costs. The Department will also monitor the air and dust around the school during the clean up to ensure the area remains safe.

No students or parents are to enter the school site on Friday Feb 22nd. The children are to assemble at the Nangiloc Hall at the normal "arrival at school" time and Mr Wright will be there at 7.45am. The bus will conduct its normal morning run dropping the children off at the hall. Mums and dads will do the same. We have arranged an excursion into Red Cliffs and this will include a 2 hour gym session at the Red Cliffs Gymnastics centre. The bus will depart from the hall at 9.00am.

Return—On our return we will drop off the children on the Iraak run on the way home, then drop off the car travellers at the hall and then on to the Colignan bus route. We plan to be back at the hall by 3.30pm, so children or the bus run will be arriving home a little earlier.

Permission note attached to todays newsletter—to be fill out, signed and returned asap.

Risk, we have been assured by all the authorities and contractor that the risk of contamination is very, very low, so please do not become alarmed. Work safe and personnel to monitor dust and air will be on site all the time. If there is the slightest hint of a problem work will cease immediately. The contractors are A class removalist from Melbourne who are required to follow the most strict protocol. The clean up will take 3 days Friday 19th—Sunday 21st. We are simply taking the safety option.
