Mobile Library hours changing

There is change in the air at Nangiloc, with Mildura Rural City Council's mobile library visiting schedule set to be adjusted as of next week.

As of Monday 3 May 2010 the mobile library will be open each Monday from 2pm to 5pm. The service previously operated from 1pm to 5pm each Monday.

Portfolio Councillor for Arts and Human Services Fiona Hilton-Wood said the change in times had been made after following community surveying and in particular those residents of the area who regularly use the mobile library service in Nangiloc. "It was found that few people visited the mobile library at Nangiloc during its first hour of operation and that those people who currently use the service would not be inconvenienced by changing the opening time," she said.

The mobile library visits Nangiloc every Monday and parks on Kulkyne Way, across from the Nangiloc General Store. Visitors to the mobile library can enjoy a full range of library services including internet access. For further details contact Council's Community Engagement Librarian on 50188347.
