Four community groups representing geographical areas hit hardest by floods will be set up as part of a plan for long-term recovery from the February disaster.

The Community Flood Recovery Committees will be made up of community leaders and representatives from organisations likely to be involved in the ongoing recovery process as well as individuals committed to the voluntary role long-term.

These committees will consider issues and impacts including (but not limited to):

- movement of residual water
- housing assistance
- psychosocial support
- agricultural production and restoration support
- road and rail restoration and repairs
- public health
- clean up coordination
- community building/business support.
