NANGILOC & DISTRICT KINDERGARTEN

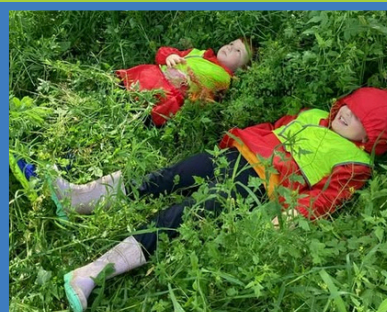
Welcome back to term 3

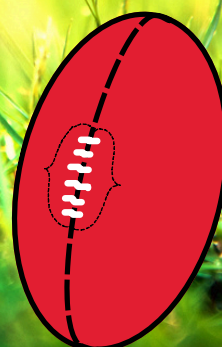

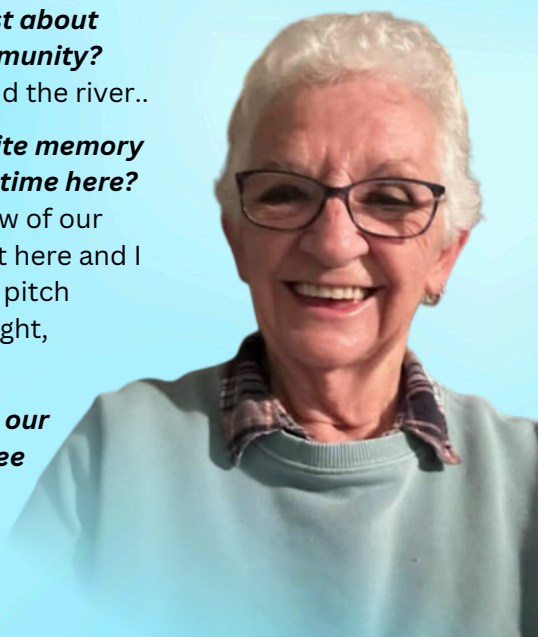
