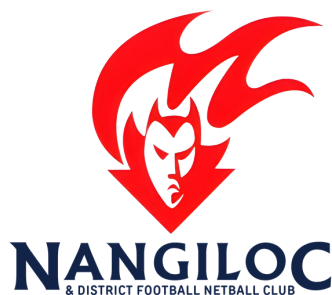

PEAR & BANANA OAT MUFFINS

Ingredients:

- ☐ 4 pears, peeled and grated
- ☐ 1 ripe banana, mashed
- ☐ 2 cups self-raising flour
- ☐ 1 cup rolled oats
- ☐ ½ cup brown sugar
- ☐ 1 tsp cinnamon
- ☐ 2 eggs
- ☐ 100g melted butter
- ☐ ½ cup milk
- ☐ 1 tsp vanilla essence



Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to 180°C (160°C fan-forced).
2. Line a 12-hole muffin tin.
3. Grate the pears and gently squeeze out a little excess juice.
4. Pour 1/4 cup batter into the middle of the fry pan (I use a slightly heaped ice cream scoop with lever, standard is 1/4 cup).
5. In a bowl, combine banana, eggs, melted butter, milk and vanilla.
6. Stir in the grated pears.
7. Add flour, oats, brown sugar and cinnamon. Mix gently until just combined – don't overmix.
8. Spoon into muffin cases, filling about ¾ full..
9. Bake for 20–25 minutes, until golden and a skewer comes out clean.
10. Cool for 5 minutes in the tin, then transfer to a rack.

Little extra: Sprinkle some oats and brown sugar on top before baking for a lovely crunchy topping

THE LONE GRAVE AT HATTAH

History hidden in the Hattah bush.

Have you ever seen the lone grave tucked away at Hattah-Kulkyne? It belongs to James Mahon, aged 63, who was found drowned in Chalka Creek on 21 December 1923.

James was laid to rest beside Chalka Creek, at the foot of a small sand hill. Almost 44 years later, his lonely grave was brought back into the pages of the Sunraysia Daily.

“The Lonely Grave” – Wally Dug It

In April 1967, the Sunraysia Daily told the story of Wally Chaplin, a local character who had lived a life of many different jobs – from farming and stock work to brickmaking and delivering newborn lambs.

Wally recalled that 44 years earlier, while farming in the area, he had dug the grave for the stockman who drowned in Chalka Creek.

At 76, Wally was living quietly in retirement in a tiny old caravan. He joked that he had never married because he “didn’t have the time”.

Wally was also a second cousin of the world-famous film director Charlie Chaplin. Their grandfathers were brothers in England, although Wally never met his famous relative.

He had served with the AIF during the First World War and later performed guard duty in Mildura. In retirement, he enjoyed taking to the road on his old motorcycle.
